A graduate of Case Western Reserve University Department of Organizational Behavior, her doctoral supervisor (Dr. David Cooperrider) was instrumental in assisting her to deepen her specialization in Appreciative Inquiry and strengths-based approaches to organization change. She is a successful international consultant, trainer and facilitator, and consults to clients in a range of sectors and at different levels of system.

Anastasia has work in over 15 countries covering Africa, Asia, Europe, South and North America. Projects include supporting macro-political change through a UNDP funded initiative in Nepal to capacitate representatives in the Constituent Assembly for the constitutional reform process; designing and facilitating multiple global strategy sessions for international corporate and not for-profit organizations; and consulting to over 50 organizations to support them with a transformation agenda.
